



Sculptor Ruth Moilliet will be showing recent work at the Platform Gallery. In contrast to her dramatic metal flowerheads, her new *Hydrangea Blue* series are smaller glass sculptures (48 x 43 cm). Made out of individual hydrangea flowers sandwiched between layers of glass which

are then clamped together in metal frames resembling a traditional flower presses, the pieces look like giant, ghostly blue flowers floating in glass. They recall sealed museum vitrines, and Moilliet uses them to comment on the way mankind attempts to control and order the natu-

ral world. Her pieces are exhibited alongside photographs by landscape artist Andy Goldsworthy. DWf
